## ClampArt Gallery



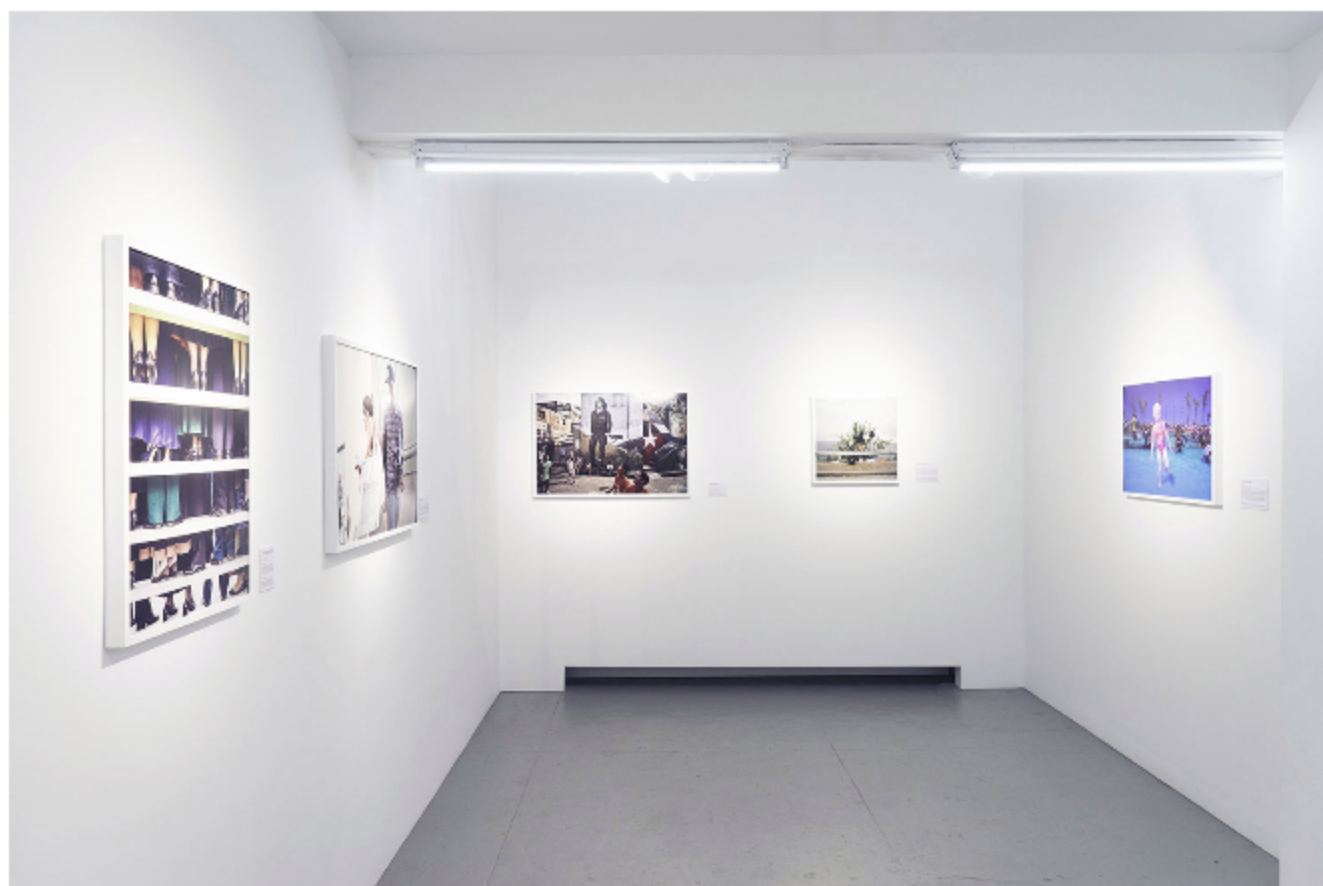
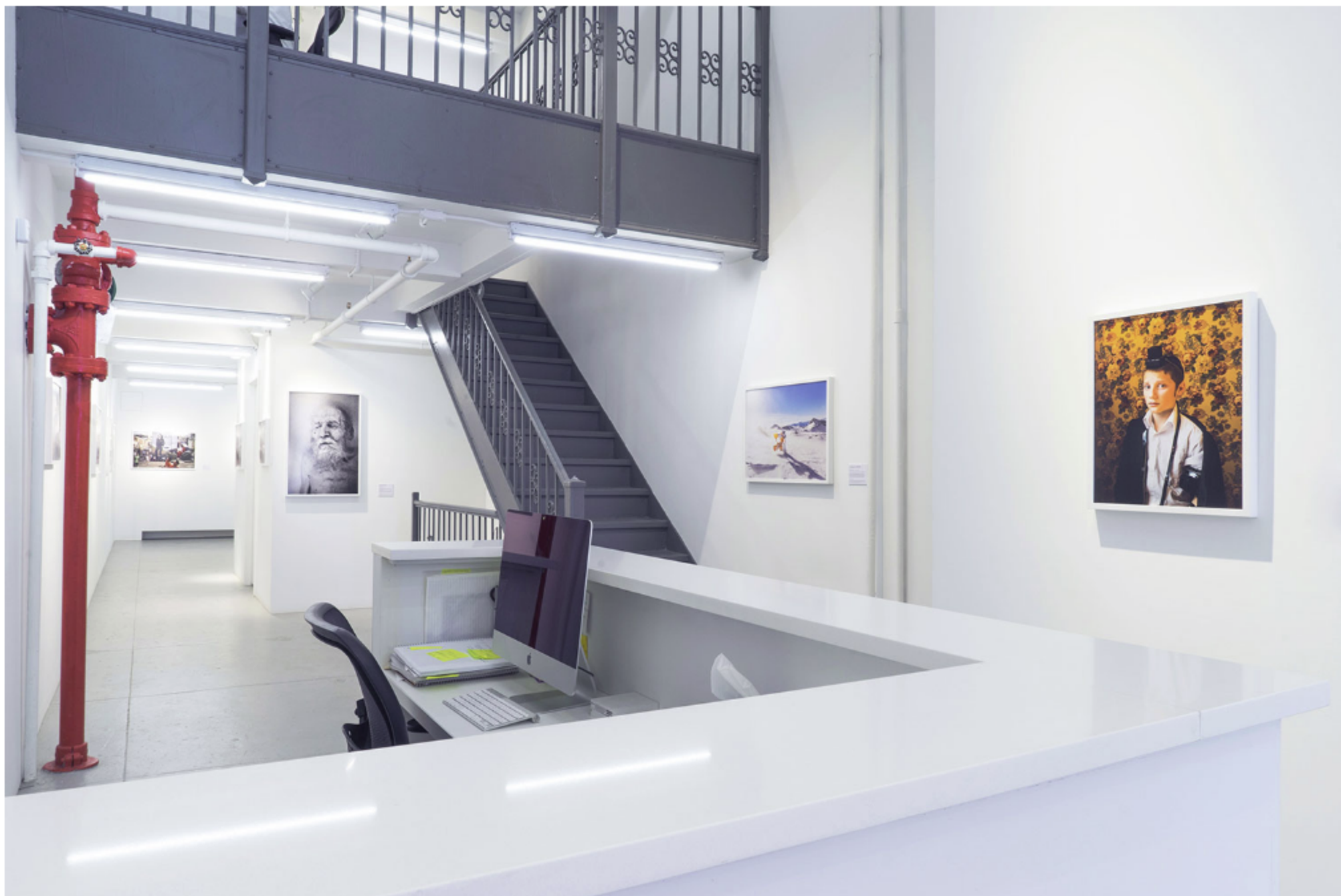
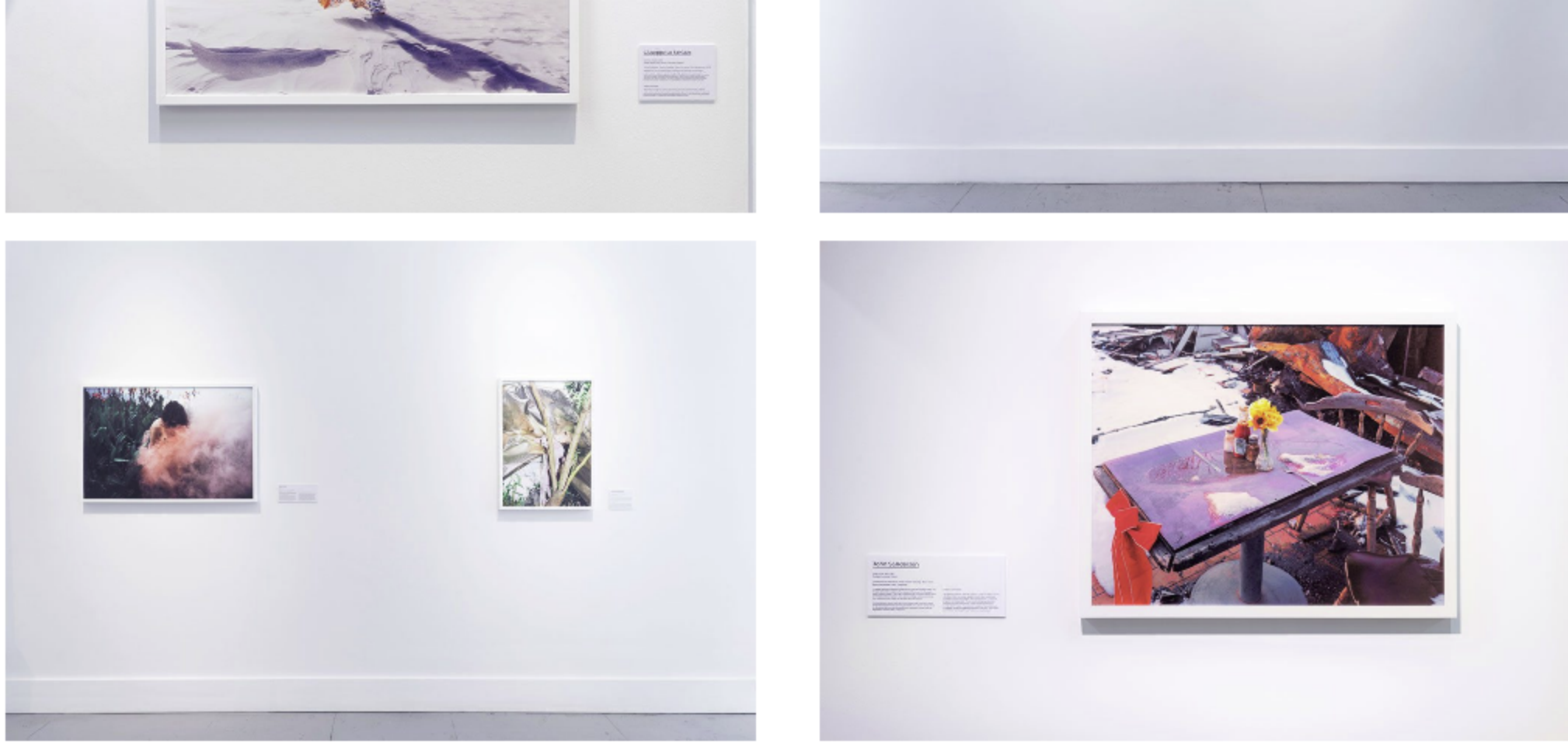
